FROM EDITOR'S DESK

Dear Colleagues,

There is a growing and justified concern about the public health and economic impact of increasing population of tobacco chewers/smokers in the country. According to WHO, tobacco killed 100million people in the 20th century and is expected to kill one billion during the 21st century (10 times increase). Global Adult Tobacco Survey 2010 reported one in three adults in india i.e. 274.9 million, use tobacco; out of which 163.7 million consume smokeless tobacco; 68.9 million smoke cigarettes and 42.3 million use both. According to WHO, those who smoke one pack of cigarettes each day live seven years less than those who have never smoked. Statistics from a cancer hospital reveal 60% of oral and lung cancers, are attributable to tobacco; 80% of these are inoperable.

In an excellent editorial "**Tobacco & Health**", published in this issue, **Prof. N.S. Neki** has brilliantly highlighted the hazards of tobacco and the urgent need for a drive against tobacco use. Also published in the issue are several interesting original articles and case reports from different disciplines of medicine. An exhaustive review on the Renal Toxic Effects of Herbal Preparations commonly prescribed as alternate remedies, is an eye-opener for the clinician.

This issue contains a **Symposium on "Anorectal Disorders : Current Management"** by **Dr. Sarabjit Singh** an expert in the field. Besides an excellent scientific editorial; symposium focuses on the current diagnostic and management strategies in some of the common disorders affecting the anorectal region. I am really grateful to Dr. Sarabjit Singh for his contribution in this issue.

I take this opportunity to thank members of editorial and advisory board for their help in the compilation of this issue and to the various advertisers for financial help provided for printing of this issue.
